

# Scourie and District Angling Club

Scourie, Sutherland

The Angling Club leases the fishing rights of 47 lochs from the Scourie Estate, all of which contain native brown trout. These lochs are divided into 2 zones as well as a loch set aside for beginners/families. Lochs are numbered as shown on the map and the associated zones are shown in the table. The club owns four rowing boats which are available for hire.

## Charges per person

- Day permit for the beginner loch £ 5.00
- Day permit to fish in a zone per person £10.00
- Week permit (6 days) £20.00
- Evening permit (after 1600) to fish a zone £ 5.00
- Boat Hire per day per boat £10.00
- Buoyancy aids loaned daily free of charged

Income from the sale of fishing permits is used for maintenance and improvement of the fishery where appropriate

Fishing is by fly only from dawn to dusk. Anglers may fish any lochs within the zone stipulated on the permit purchased. Consideration must be given to other anglers on the same loch.

All anglers must read and agree to abide by the club rules.

Permits available from 0900-1300 and 1400-1700, Monday to Saturday from The Fishing Tackle shop in the Scourie Filling Station.

## RULES

- Fishing is by fly only and from dawn to dusk.
- Trout less than 8 inches long must be put back alive and care exercised to prevent injury.
- Particulars of catch to be given. The club is bound to keep records by directive of Scottish Executive.
- The permit must be returned to the point of purchase by hand or by post within 7 days of its expiry, recording all fish caught
- Any person using a boat must wear a buoyancy aid at all times.
- Users of a club boat should observe due care in its use and insure that the boat is returned to it's mooring in a clean, tidy and bailed condition. The boat should be securely tied up and locked so as to avoid rub and wear to the boat. The keys should be returned by dusk each day.
- Permits, fish and tackle in possession of holder shall be exhibited to any permit holder on request.
- Dogs to be kept under control at owners responsibility against damage to stock.
- Cars to be parked off road and not in passing spaces.
- The club reserves the right to withdraw the permit if these rules are breached.
- The holder of a permit understands that the Scourie and District Angling Club will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered during the use of any club boats, equipment or property.

Season - 15<sup>th</sup> March to 30<sup>th</sup> September (Boats available after 1<sup>st</sup> May)
